How to control scale



Scale is a rough sand paper like calcium deposition on the pool interior. It can brush off like chalk and cause cloudiness and bather discomfort.

Cause

- Usually caused by incorrect water balance.
- High calcium levels
- Some pool finishes are prone to calcium build ups

Problem

- Rough build up of deposits on wall and floor
- Short filter cycles
- Equipment failure

Prevention

- Correct water balance
- Regular use of **Filrite Scale Eliminator**.
Salt water pools should use **Filrite Salt Cell Protector Plus**.
- Using **Calcium Hardness Decreaser** to lower calcium level



'Follow these simple steps to control scale in your pool'

Solution

Nail The Scale

- Used to remove calcium scale deposits from swimming pool surfaces.
- Contains a special blend of 3 organic acids and synthetic chelating agents.
- May be used in all types of pool finishes.
- For best results add the product as close as possible to the stained area.
- Do not allow direct contact with coloured marble pool finishes or printed vinyl liners.

Step 1

- **Nail The Scale** may be sprinkled over stained area or distributed around the pool.
- Add 2 kg per 50,000 litres.

Step 2

- Widespread staining is best treated by distributing the product over the pool surface. Never add via the skimmer basket or filter.

Step 3

- **Filrite Stain and Scale Control** must then be added immediately to prevent re-staining. The product should then be added again at regular monthly intervals.
- Add 1 lt per 50,000 litres of pool water.

Step 4

- **Nail The Scale** is a strong acid mixture. When added to the pool water it will lower its pH and total alkalinity.

Step 5

- Pool water must be re-balanced following use of **Nail The Scale**.
