## Cause

- Metals, usually in the water, coming out of solution
- Organic staining (decaying leaves, etc.)
- Objects, ( such as metal filings, bobby pins etc.) entering the pool.

## Problem

- Unsightly blemishes
- May also lead to deterioration of heaters and pumps

## Prevention

- Correct water balance
- The use of **Filtrite Stain and Scale Control** will help greatly to prevent staining from occurring.

## Solution

### IMPOTRANT:

- **Filtrite Stain Eliminator** should not be used in vinyl lined pools
- Do not allow contact with coloured marblesheen pool finishes. In this situation place the product in a sock or stocking attached to the end of a pool pole and hold very close to the affected area without actually touching it. This is also effective for treatment of spots rather than wider staining.

### Step 1

- Have water analysed and balanced at your local Clark Rubber store.

### Step 2

- Allow chlorine level to drop to maximum 0.5 ppm.

### Step 3

- Apply **Filtrite Stain Eliminator** directly onto affected areas and leave stand for 24 hours.

### Step 4

- Add chlorine and rebalance pool water

### Step 5

- After 5 days add **Filtrite Stain and Scale Control** to prevent metals coming out of solution and restaining pool interior. Add 25ml per 10,000 litres weekly.
