Maintaining your pool in Winter will save you time and money in Summer.

Some pool owners neglect their pool over Winter. At the beginning of spring they are faced with a swamp that costs unnecessary time and money to make their pool suitable for swimming.

If you still swim in your pool over Winter, you will need to maintain sanitiser levels between 2 - 3 ppm

IMPORTANT:

Do not use *Filtrite Algygone* and *Filtrite Extreme Algaecide* in any pool using an Ironiser or Nature² or a liquid chlorine feeder. In situations like this, we recommended *Filtrite Ultimate Algaecide*.



'Following these simple steps to look after your pool in Winter'

Step 1

- Have your pool water professionally analysed at your Clark Rubber store to achieve correct water balance.

Step 2

- Shock dose your pool with 500 gms **Aqua Boost** per 25,000 litres.
- Repeat dose every month.

Step 3

- Add **Filtrite Algygone** at 1 litre per 50,000 litres every 3 months.

Step 4

- Add **Filtrite Phosphate Eliminator** at the required dosage rate.

Step 5

- Maintain sanitiser level between 1-2 ppm over winter if not using the pool.

Step 6

- Run filter 2 hours per day.

Handy Tips

- A pool cover or solar blanket will assist in preventing dirt and leaves from entering your pool.
- Regularly empty baskets to prevent clogging from leaves and debris
